

Tuesday, September 15, 2009- GLCC Meeting Minutes

- I. **Meeting called to order** at Gino's Pizzeria in Keego Harbor by President Terry Anway at 7:12 pm. 19 members were in attendance.
- II. **Introduction of Officers:** President Terry Anway, Treasurer Dave Courter and Secretary Lynn Pappas were present.
